



Sister Section Agreement between IEEE Twin Cities (USA) and Ottawa (Canada) Sections


1. Twin Cities and Ottawa Sections by mutual consent have entered into a long term, voluntary relationship for the purpose of exchanging ideas and experiences on how to benefit from each others' operations.
2. This agreement is for a three-year term and does not imply a financial or legal relationship. This will be an IEEE pilot project. It will take effect on October 1, 2008.
3. The desire and basis for a Sister Section Agreement between two Sections has been approved by the Section Executive Committees of the two Sections and is submitted here for the approval by Directors of Region 4 (Robert Dawson) and Region 7 (Ferial El-Hawary). The interface between Sister Sections shall be primarily by email, and may involve frequent communications between officers with similar responsibilities.
4. Initial activities will be established by the prime contacts of Twin Cities Section (Arun Kumar, 2008 Chair) and Ottawa Section (Wahab Almuhtadi, 2008 Chair). As interest develops in particular, other officer/s may communicate directly as sub committee, reporting a summary topics, to the prime contacts. The prime contacts plan to submit a summary report on their activities/progress to their respective Regional Directors every six months.
